<b>EXTRAORDINARY LEAVE FOR FAMILY REASONS (COVID-19)</b>	CNS INDEMNITÉS PÉCUNIAIRES L-2900 LUXEMBOURG	Leave for Family Reasons	<a href="#">LINK</a>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Parents who have to look after their child(ren) under 13 years old</li> <li>Leave for family reasons may be taken by a parent of such a child if no other childcare options are available.</li> <li>If necessary, parents may alternate taking leave for family reasons. If so, each parent must send in a separate form.</li> </ul> <a href="#">LINK</a>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The parent must inform his or her employer about the leave as soon as possible by indicating the beginning and the end of the period;</li> <li>The form must be completed (period does not have to be mentioned on the form, only mentioned to employer);</li> <li>The form must be sent to the employer and to the CNS once per parent taking the leave. If the leave is split - taken several times over a longer period of time - the parent is not required to send a new form each time. <b>SHORT-TIME WORKING IN THE EVENT OF FORCE MAJEURE</b>	MINISTRY OF THE ECONOMY - ECONOMIC COMMITTEE NATIONAL EMPLOYMENT AGENCY (ADEM) <a href="#">LINK</a>	Support measure for businesses that can no longer carry out their activity due to the occurrence of an external event beyond their control.  Sole proprietors cannot apply at the moment, to be noted  There are currently two procedures.  The "standard" one is subject to the use of the normal form, that can now be sent by email at <a href="mailto:emploi@eco.etat.lu">emploi@eco.etat.lu</a>  Please note that two separate forms must be sent, for both March and April no later than March 20th if applicants want to have their applications checked on the 23rd (economic committee to be held)	<a href="#">LINK</a>	<p>The short-time working scheme in the case of force majeure can be applied to employees who are not covered by a certificate of incapacity for work and who can no longer be employed at all or can no longer be employed on a full-time basis:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>when the company cannot ensure the continuation of its normal economic activity, while the supplier of raw materials can no longer deliver or no longer provide the necessary volume for reasons related to the coronavirus, or if there is a significant drop in demand from customers or users due to the coronavirus.</li> <li>if, due to absences of staff caused by external decisions related to the coronavirus, a company cannot continue its normal economic activity, or if, in the same context, one or more departments of the company are completely at a standstill.</li> </ul> <p>It applies in principle to all economic sectors where the causes are directly related to the coronavirus.</p>	<p>In order to apply for the scheme, a written request must be submitted by the employer or their representative, at the latest on the occurrence of the facts, and without having to take account of the normal period of introduction, to the secretariat of the Economic and Social Committee (Comité de conjoncture) at the Ministry of Economy by means of a special dedicated form which must be signed by the president of the delegation of staff or their representative or, if there is no staff delegation, by all the employees concerned.</p> <p>All applications for short-time work must be sent:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>by email to <a href="mailto:emploi@eco.etat.lu">emploi@eco.etat.lu</a>, or</li> <li>by post to the following address: Ministère de l'Economie - Comité de conjoncture (19-21), boulevard Royal L-2914 Luxembourg</li> </ul> <p>The ministerial authorisations granted only cover one month of short-time work. <b>TAX RELIEF MEASURES</b>	Given the current crisis resulting from the spread of the virus Covid-19, the government has decided to implement several tax measures in favour of legal persons (companies) as also natural persons. The main objective of these measures is to overcome the needs for financing and cash flows of the companies and self-employed persons ("indépendants") who are currently strongly impacted by the current economic constraints.						
<b>DIRECT TAXES</b>	LUXEMBOURG INLAND REVENUE <a href="#">LINK</a>	Cancellation of the advance payments due for the first semester of 2020	<a href="#">LINK</a>	Legal persons (companies) and natural persons carrying out an activity generating a business/commercial profit, an agricultural or a forest-linked profit or a profit coming from a liberal profession, facing cash flow issues due to the Covid-19 pandemic, can make a simple demand to the Tax Authorities to cancel the tax advance payments for the two first quarters of 2020.  Solely when advance payments are due after February 29th!	How to proceed? You need to complete and sign the following form and send it (per mail) to the relevant Tax Authorities ("Bureau d'imposition"). The form only exists in French for the time being. The extended payment term will not induce any kind of late payment interests or fines.	How to proceed? This new deadline is also to be taken into consideration by any taxpayer willing to request, amend or revoke its individual tax assessment method.			
<b>INDIRECT TAXES</b>	REGISTRATION DUTIES, ESTATES AND VAT AUTHORITY <a href="#">LINK</a>	Reimbursement of VAT credit balances of less than 10.000 EUR	<a href="#">LINK</a>	N/A	Starting this week (16.03), the relevant Tax Authorities ("Administration de l'Enregistrement et des Domaines") will automatically reimburse all the credit balances in terms of VAT that amount to 10.000 EUR or less. It is estimated that this measure should be helpful for about 20.000 companies in Luxembourg.
